

Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey Academic Year 2021-22

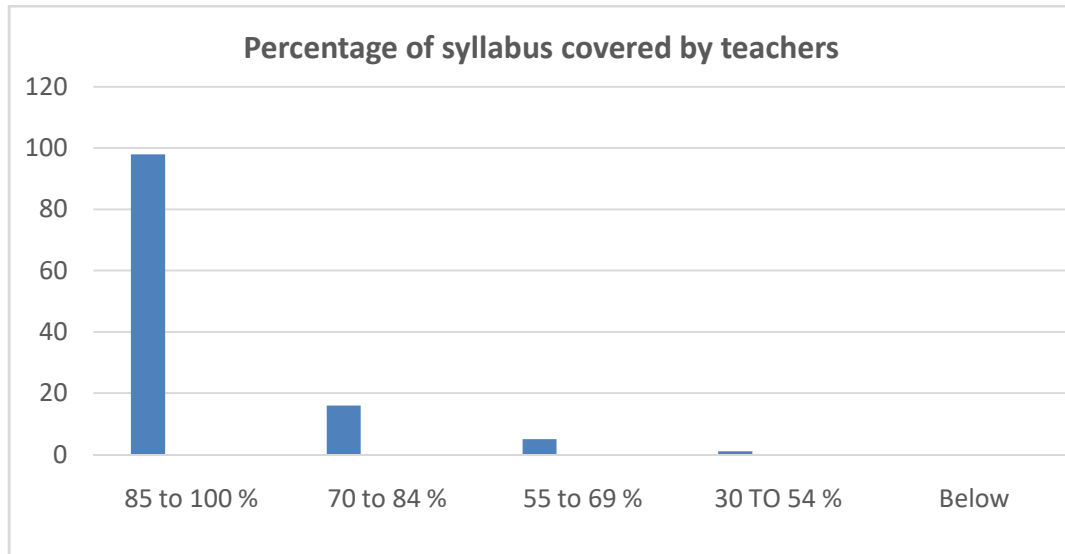
Shri Shivaji College of Arts, Commerce and Science's Internal Quality Assurance Cell conducted a survey on teaching-process, and other aspects of academics. The questionnaire comprises of 20 multiple choice questions and 1 subjective question for giving feedback and overall observation. The survey was analyzed and forwarded to the respective authority.

The survey analysis revealed the following points:

- The students gave a positive response to the questions asked. Students expressed their satisfaction toward the teaching, and evaluation. The students are happy with the efforts made by institute and the teachers for inculcating life skills, and other soft skills. The students showed their less satisfaction for internship opportunities, field projects and experiential learning. Students also showed that ICT tools should be used more during the classes.

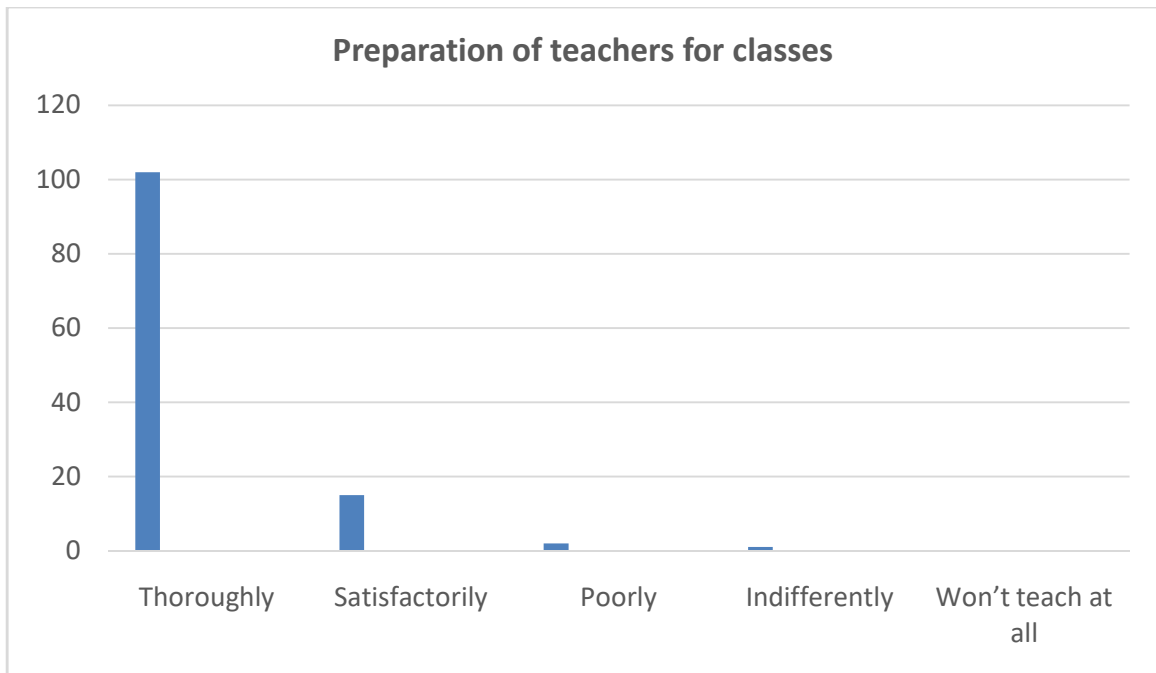
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

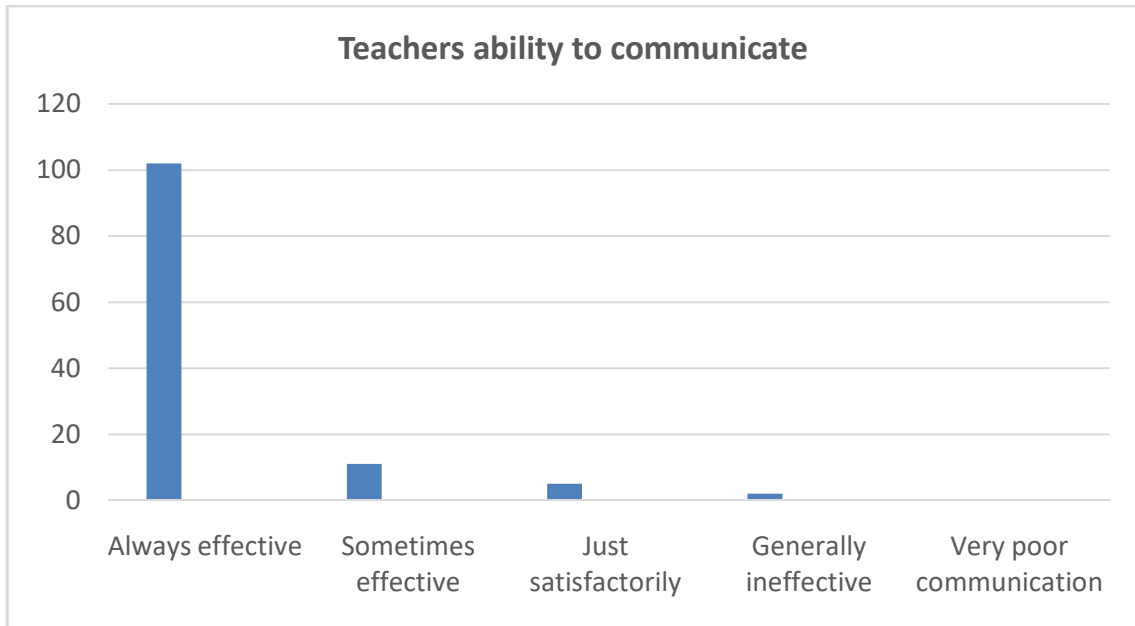
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

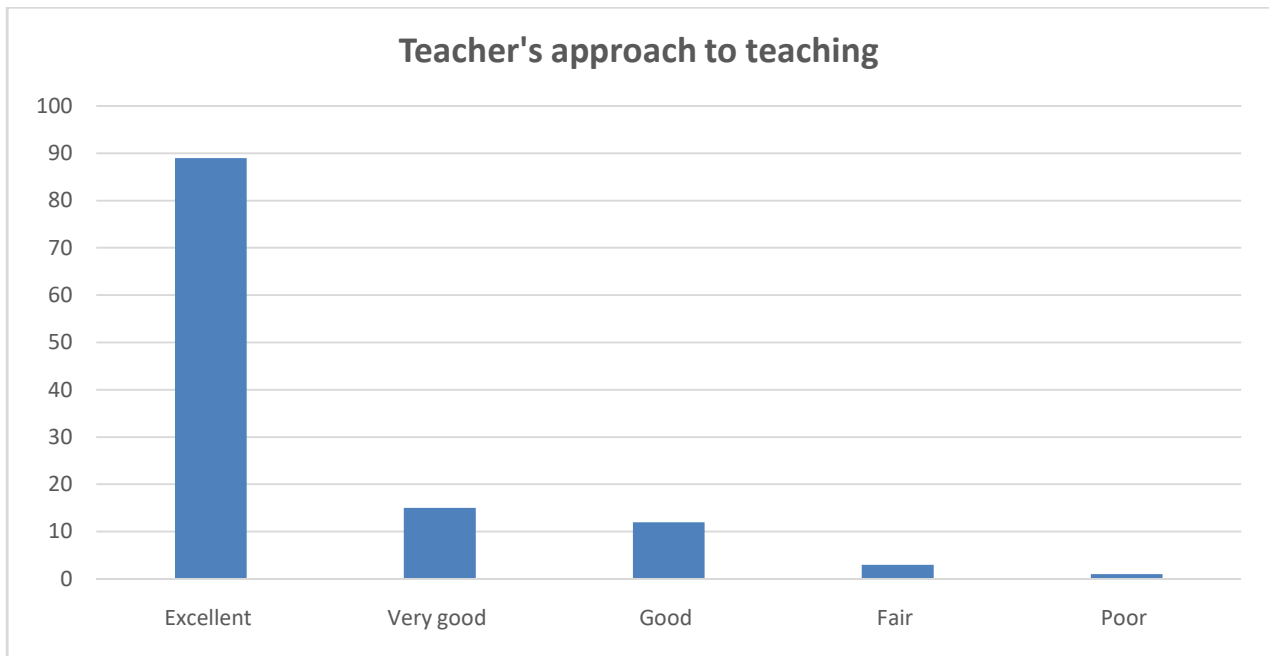
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

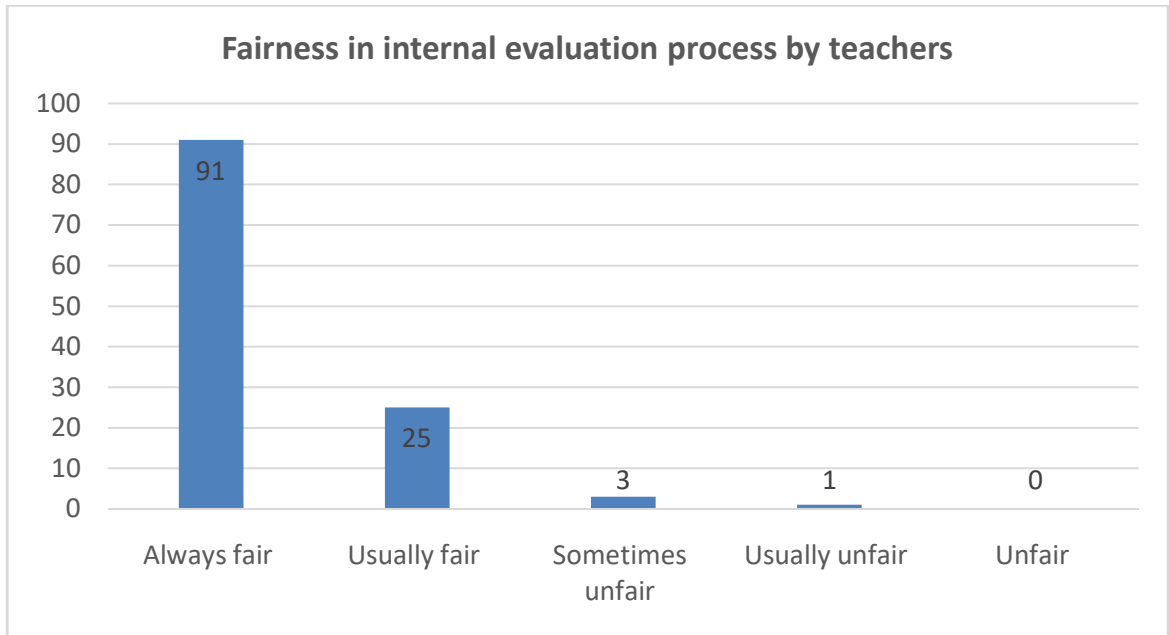
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

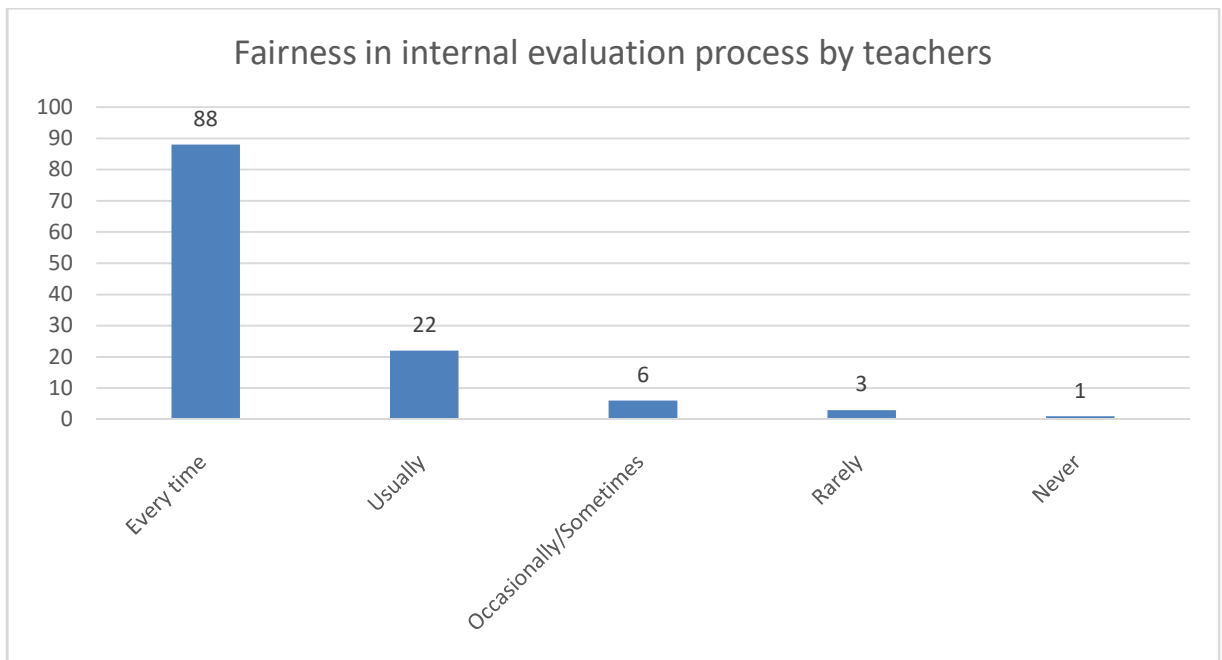
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

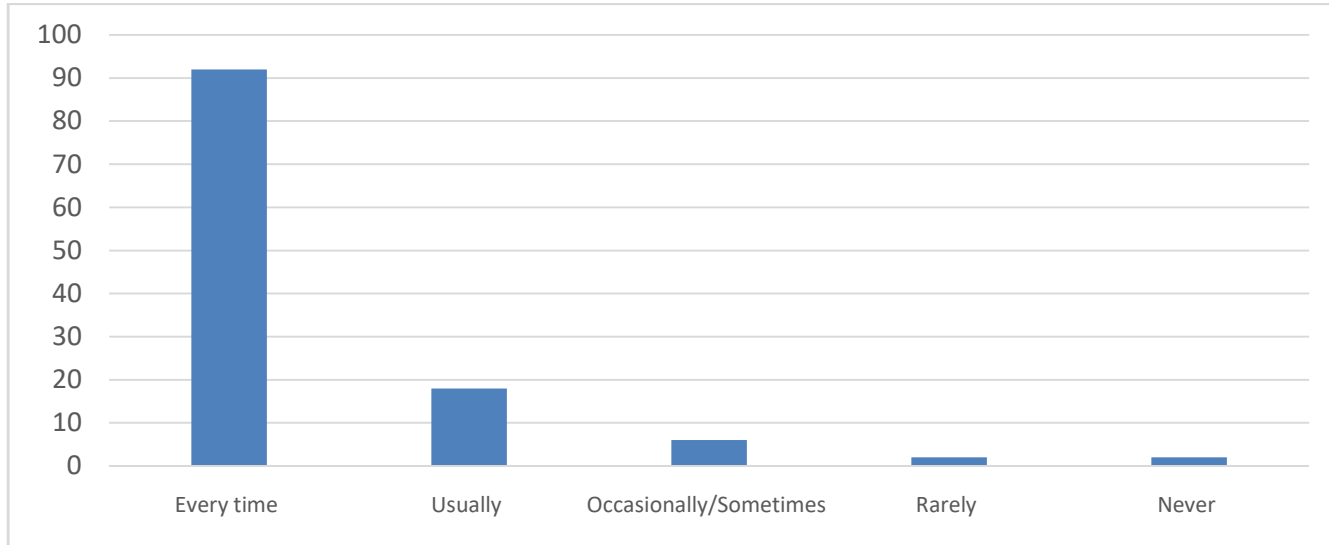
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

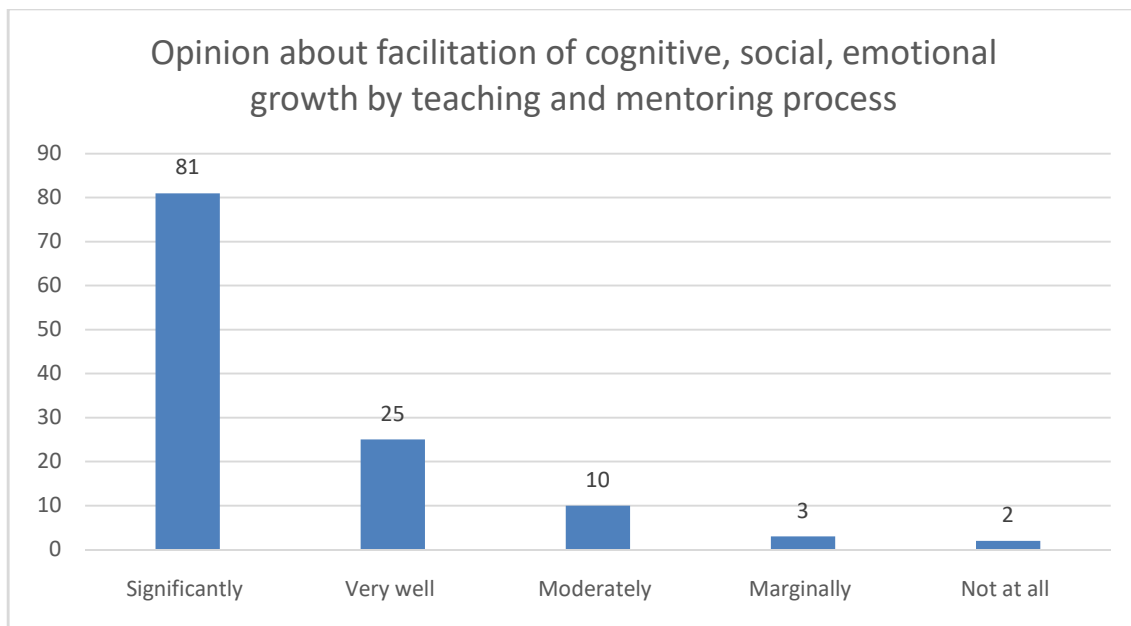
7. The institute takes an active interest in promoting internships, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.

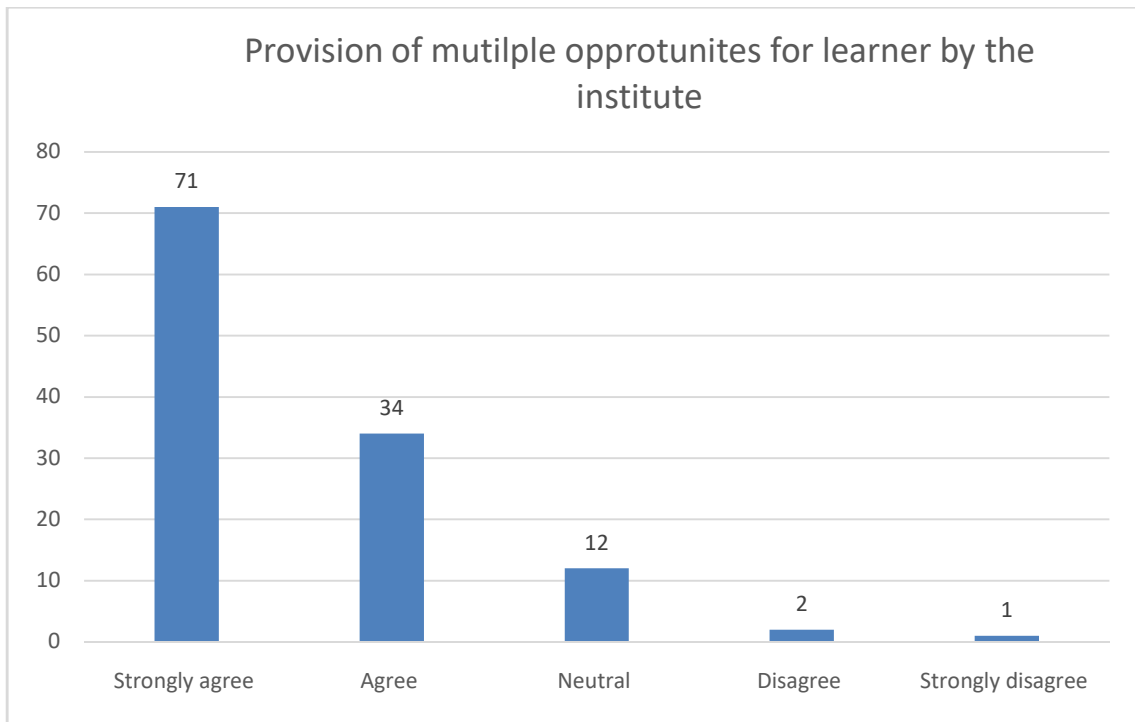

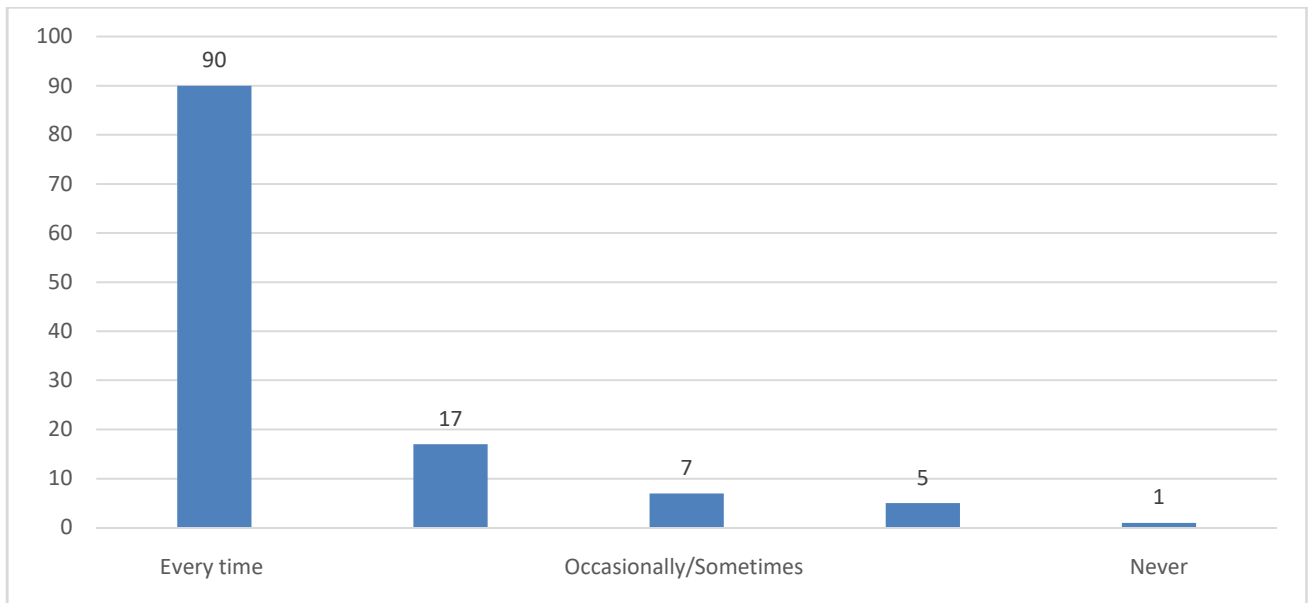

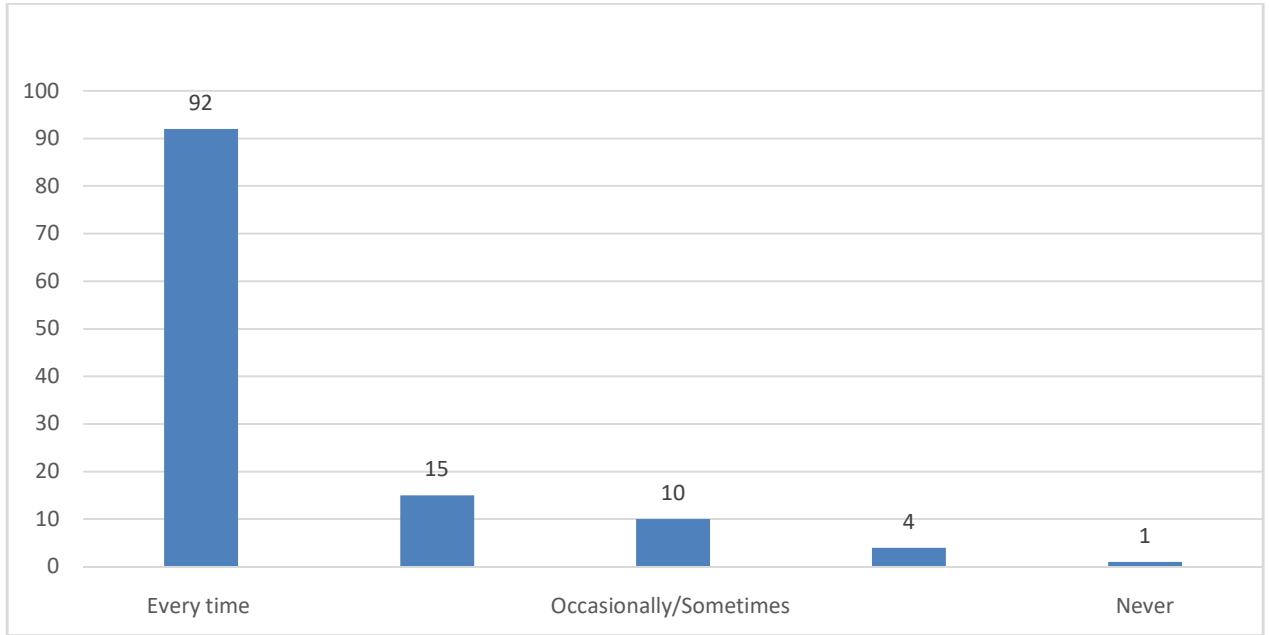

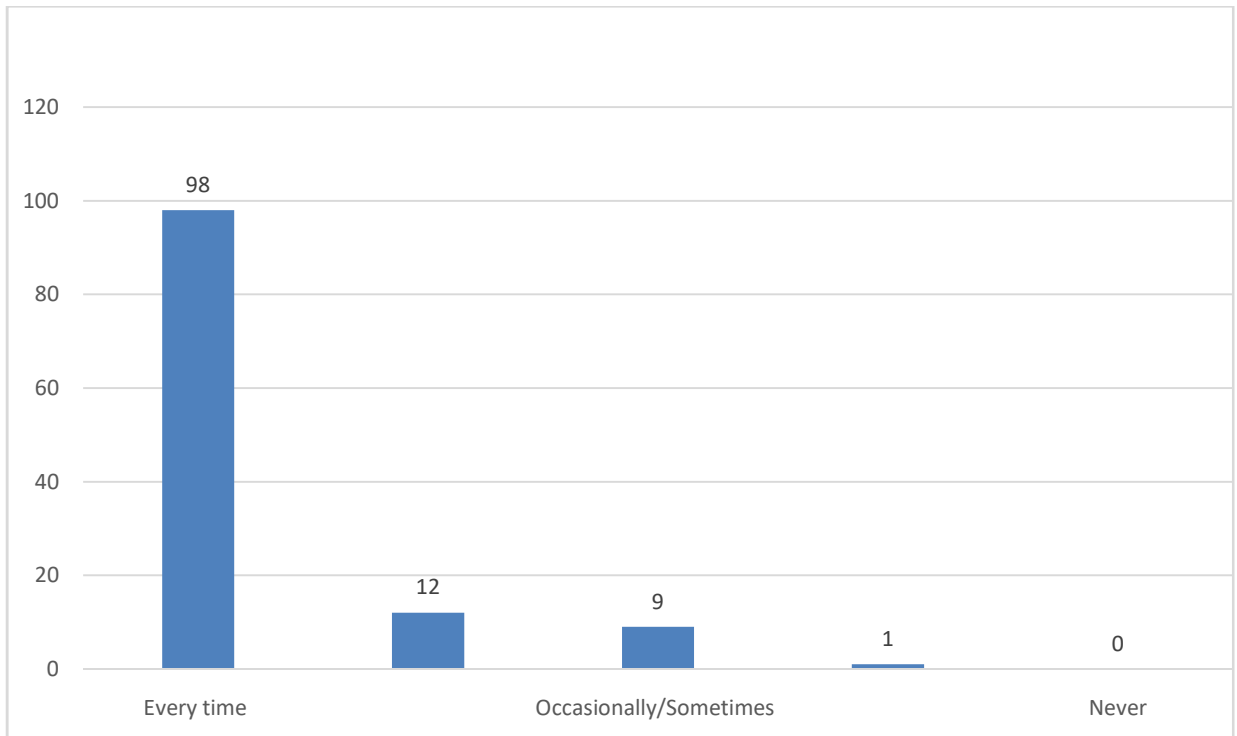

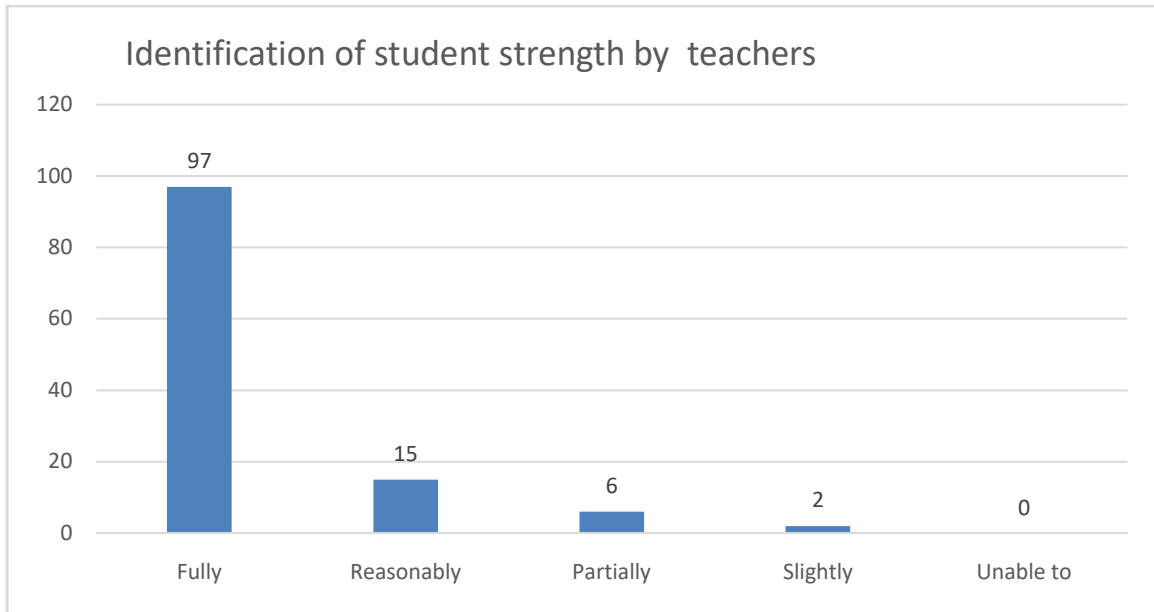
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

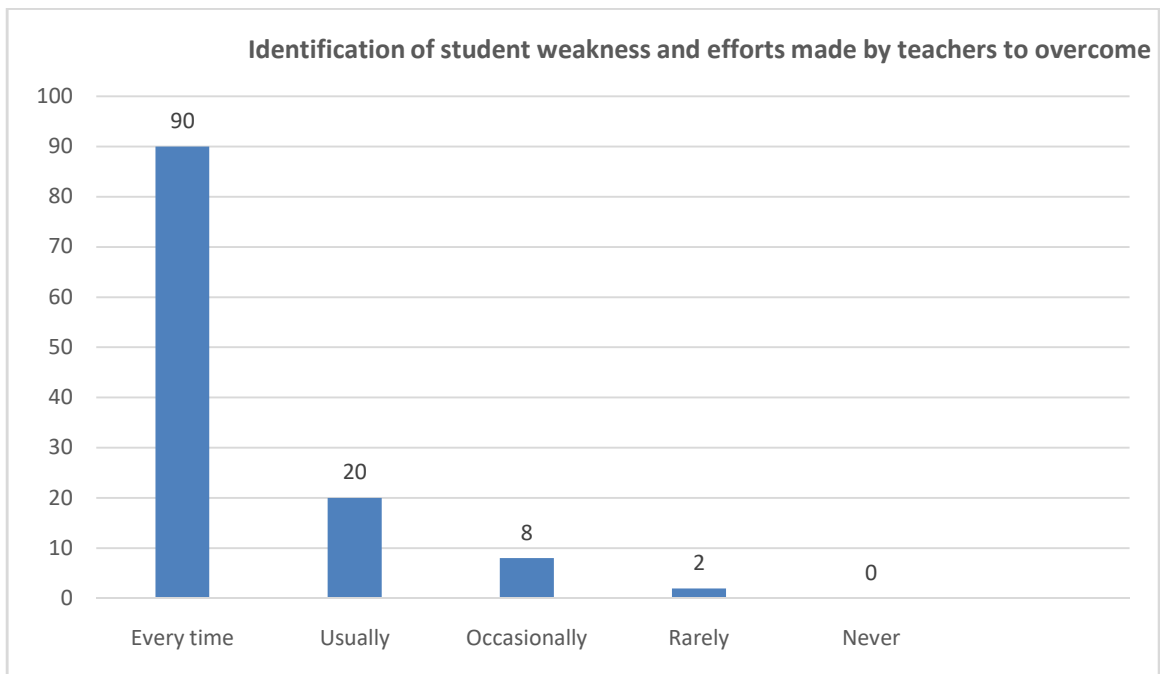

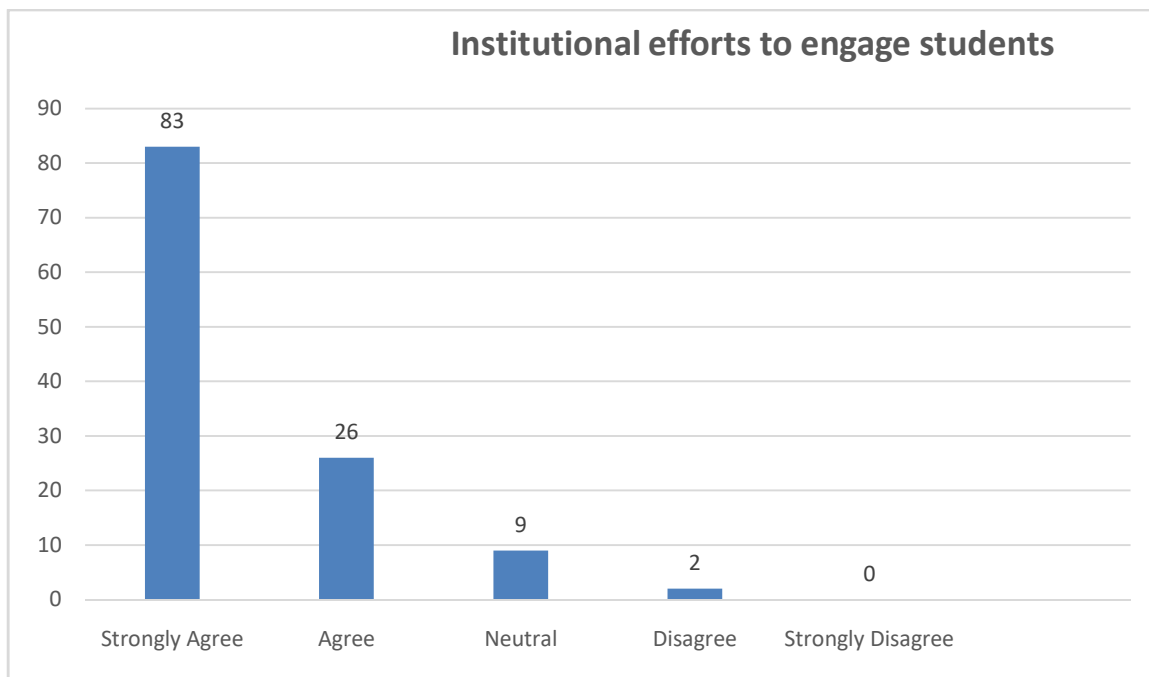
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them

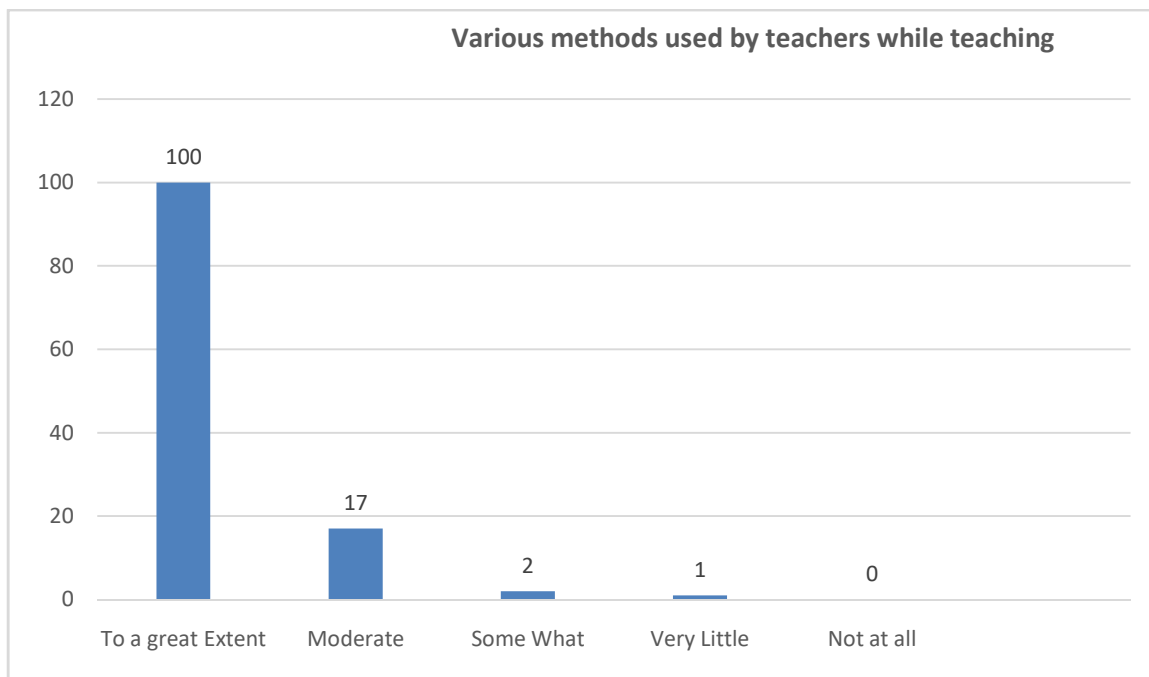
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

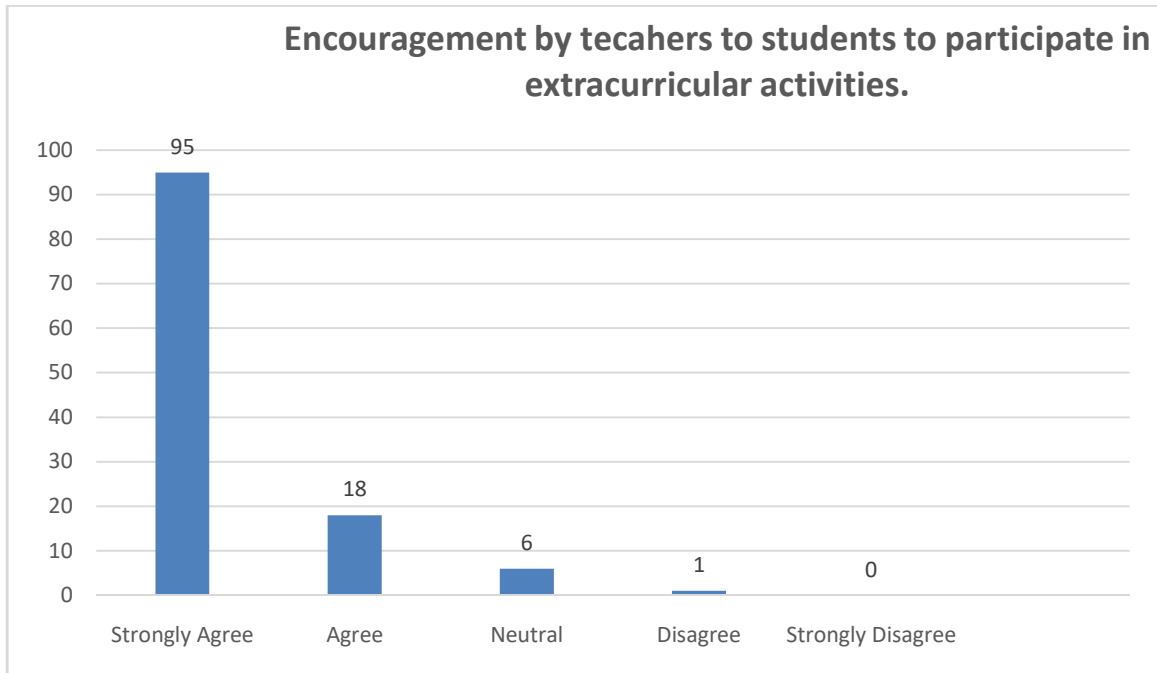
16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

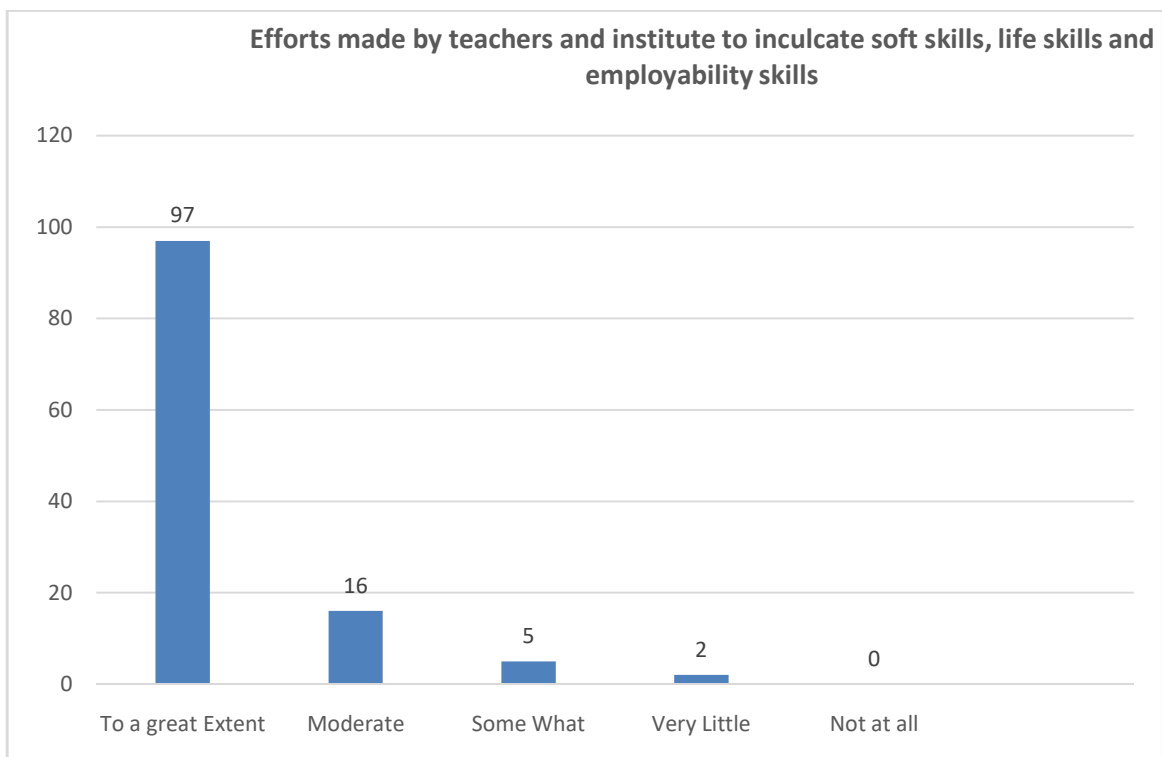
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

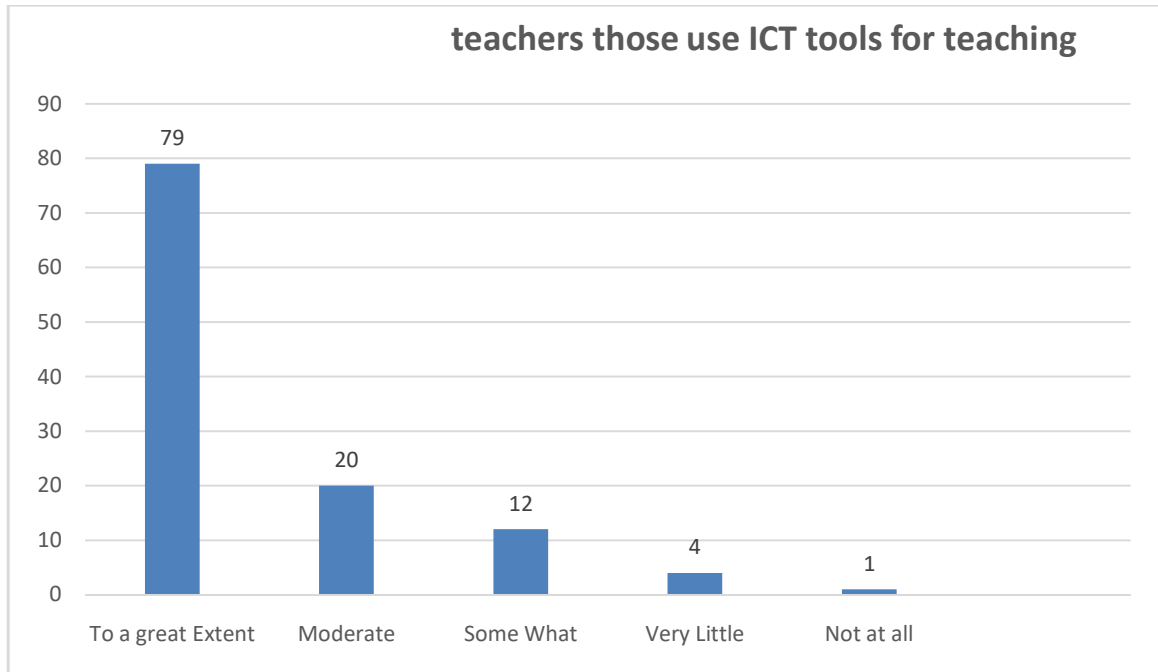
18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

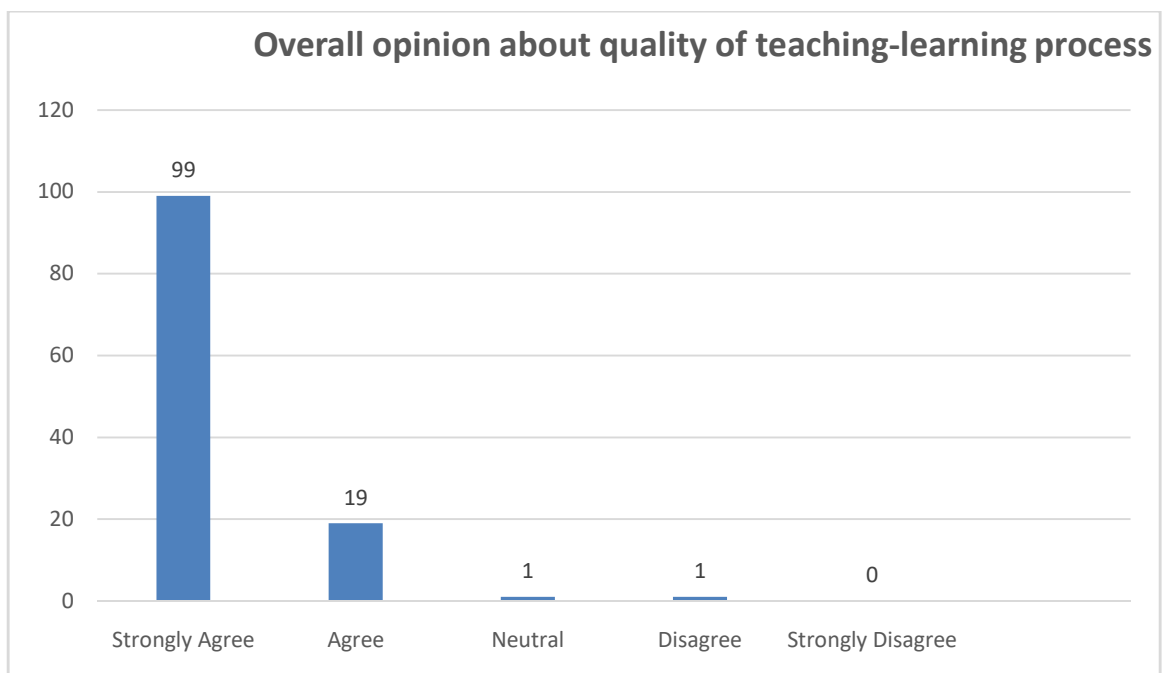
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
